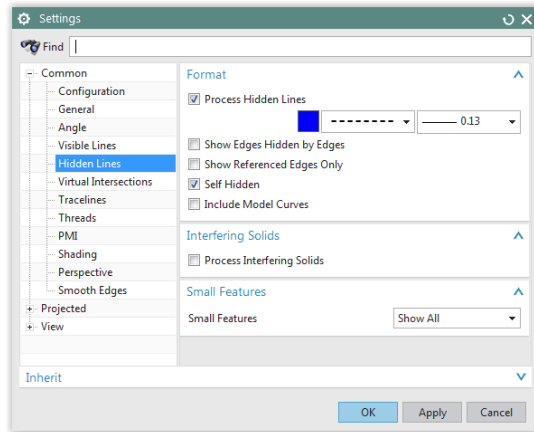
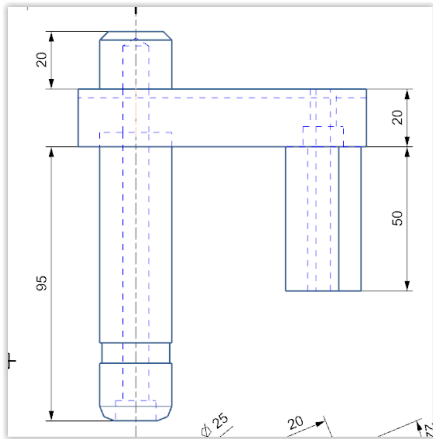


## NX10 Show specific Hidden lines via View Dependent Edit

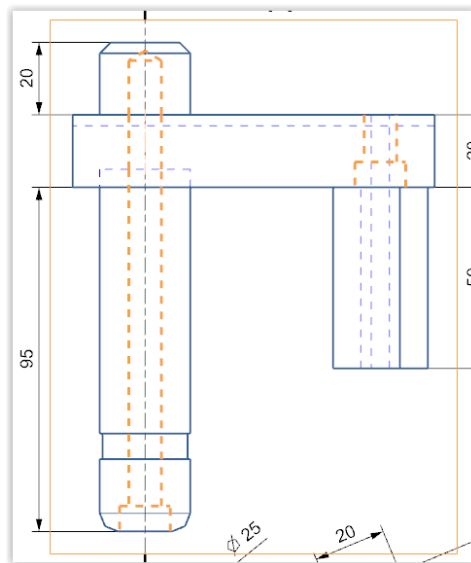
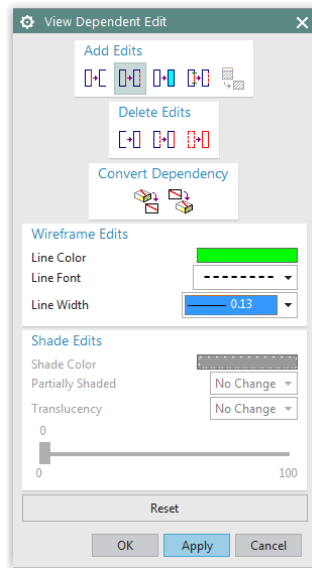
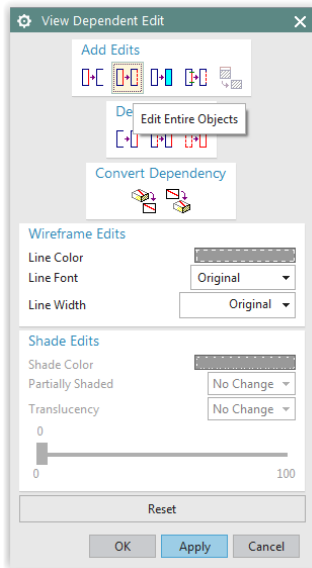
Sometimes it's useful to only show some specific Hidden lines in a view to make it clearer.



Default Hidden view --> all Hidden lines are shown

This can be done using View Dependent Edit :

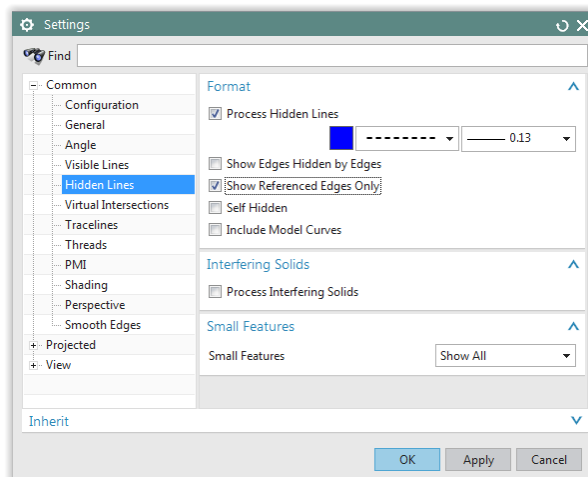
- \* Entire Objects
- \* set Line Color, Line Font, ... --> Apply
- \* select only the Hidden lines that need to stay visible



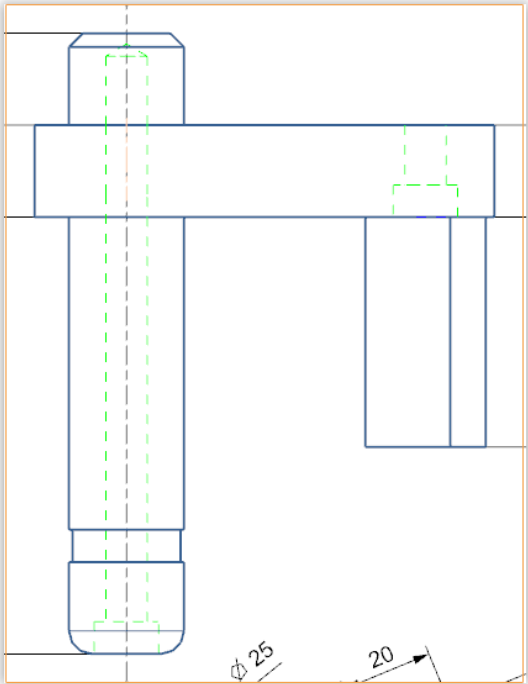
\* O.K.

To get rid of all other Hidden lines in the view, View Settings-Common-Hidden Lines-Hidden Lines active, only check :

- \* "Process Hidden Lines"
- \* "Show Referenced Edges Only"



Now only the Hidden lines via View Dependent Edits are visible.
