

NX10 Show specific Hidden lines via View Dependent Edit

Sometimes it's useful to only show some specific Hidden lines in a view to make it clearer.






Default Hidden view --> all Hidden lines are shown

This can be done using View Dependent Edit:


- * Entire Objects
- * set Line Color, Line Font, ... --> Apply
- * select only the Hidden lines that need to stay visible




* O K

To get rid of all other Hidden lines in the view, View Settings-Common-Hidden Lines-Hidden Lines active, only check :

- * "Process Hidden Lines"
- * "Show Referenced Edges Only"



Now only the Hidden lines via View Dependent Edits are visible.
