

Using DRAWORDER command returns 'Unknown command'

Issue

The following message displays when you use the DRAWORDER command:

Unknown command.

This message displays whether you use `draworder` or `dr` on the command line, or the Tools menu (Tools > Display Order).

Solution

The `dorder.arn` file has become unloaded.

To reload `dorder.arn`:

1. On the command line, type `appload` and press ENTER.
2. In the Load AutoLISP, ADS, and ARX Files dialog box, Choose File.
3. Select ARX(*.arn) from the Files of Type list.
4. Browse to the folder where the ARX files are located.

The default location is C:\Program Files\AutoCAD R14\.

5. Select the `dorder.arn` file and choose Open.
6. Choose Load.

The DRAWORDER command should now work.
